








Medieval Color Comes to Light: Concept and Deliverable

- Nasher Museum (client) wanted to increase viewer engagement with Medieval collection
- <u>Finding</u>: Medieval statuary appears out of context and stripped of its original color in Museum setting
- <u>Product:</u> Designed a tablet interface connected to a projection mapping to allow visitors to "paint" statuary with light.
 - Contributed to prototyping, content research, pitch, design, and final installation
- <u>Outcome</u>: Nasher sees major increase in visitor engagement with Medieval collection and visit duration








Queer X Scape Concept and Installation
